## There is a way...

The Sisters of Charity of New York are a Catholic, apostolic congregation of women founded in 1809 by the first American-born saint, St. Elizabeth Ann Seton. From Mother Seton's founding up to the present, we have dedicated ourselves to revealing God's love for all in need.

Recognizing that the charism of Charity is God's gift to the world and not the exclusive province of the Sisters, we happily offer an *Associate Relationship* program. This program offers women and men of various backgrounds the opportunity to share in our mission and charism while enriching us with their vision of Christian life.

#### Who May Become an Associate?

The Associate Relationship is open to all women and men who share our vision, *regardless* of marital status or religious affiliation. Associates maintain their own living and work arrangements, and are financially independent from the Congregation.

### A Mission to Change the World

Associates help carry out our mission to respond to the signs of the times as we reveal God's love for all in need, especially the poor. Social justice is a constant theme for our Sisters

and Associates, and grows out of our recognition of Christ in one another and in all whom we serve through various ministries.

#### A Unique Spiritual Tradition

There are many ways to make a difference in the world. What sets apart the Sisters of Charity and our Associates is that we share a commitment to action grounded in a unique sense of spirituality. St. Elizabeth Ann Seton asked us to consider how we encounter God all the time in our daily activities – a tradition which continues to unfold as we honor the following virtues:

- Humility Grounded in truth, allowing God to work in us.
- **Simplicity** Awareness unencumbered by material goods.
- Charity Embracing every person as a neighbor in love and justice.



### Special Activities of Associates

In addition to sharing in the spiritual life of the Sisters of Charity of New York, Associates have the opportunity to help shape the direction of the Congregation as we forge ahead in the 21st century:

- Membership on committees
- Participation in events such as Assemblies, jubilees, profession ceremonies and workshops
- Contributing to publications of the Congregation
- Retreats and other gatherings for Associates

#### How does one become an Associate?

The first step is to contact us, so that we can help you get to know the Sisters' mission and charism more deeply. Through prayer, education, social activities and guided reflections, you will have the chance to explore your own heart, and discern whether becoming an Associate of the Sisters of Charity is right for you. After a period of preparation, new Associates choose to commit themselves to living the mission and charism of the Congregation in a special Associate Ceremony.
