
December 2024 SCNY Office of Peace, Justice and Integrity of Creation Update

- ➤ listening and being willing to listen
- ➤ cooperating
- > connecting in love.

We show concern and compassion through attitudes and actions that embrace respect, reverence, curiosity, creativity, sharing, joy, gratitude and hope!

We pray and act to stop injustices like sexism and racism. We commit to being peacemakers and to collaborating with and for all our Earth Community.

DRAFT 2

We must all be concerned about human suffering wherever it arises and the state of the earth if we are to live in awareness of interdependence and interact with the world around us. To Hope and Act with Creation, we serve our Earth and those in need with compassion, humility, and a deep reverence for the interconnectedness of all life. There is a call to emphasize values like creativity, reverence, open heartedness, becoming, love, concern, respect, gratitude, joy, and awe. Some of these values:

Creativity

- Celebrate the endless potential for growth and transformation
- Embrace new ways of thinking and problem-solving

Reverence

- Honor the sacredness of the natural world
- Approach each person and situation with deep respect
- Cultivate a humble, contemplative spirit

Open Heart

- Seek to understand diverse perspectives with empathy
- Welcome all with a spirit of radical acceptance
- · Foster connections that transcend differences

Becoming

- Acknowledge that we are always in a state of co-creation
- Commit to ongoing personal and collective growth

Love

- Extend compassion, kindness, and care to all
- Recognize our profound interdependence


Gratitude

- Recognize our interconnectedness as a source of joy and wonder
